1st October to 31st December 2021

❖ A virtual interactive awareness session on sports for persons with cerebral palsy was conducted by resource persons from Cerebral Palsy Sports Federation of India (CPSFI) on 18th October 2021. All the staff members of the centre took part in the training programme.



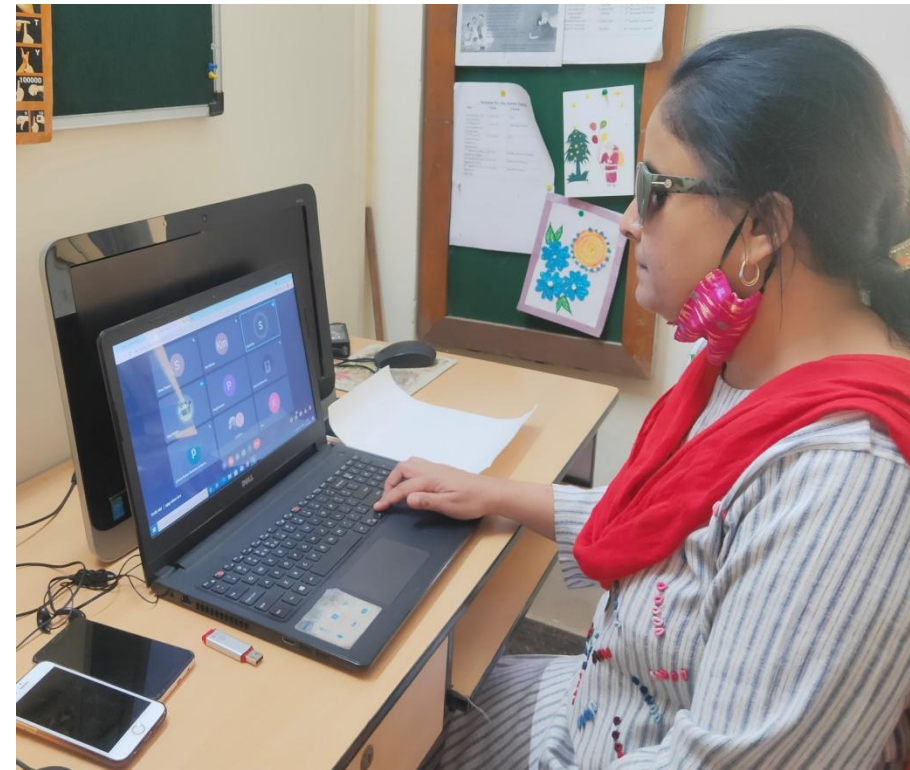
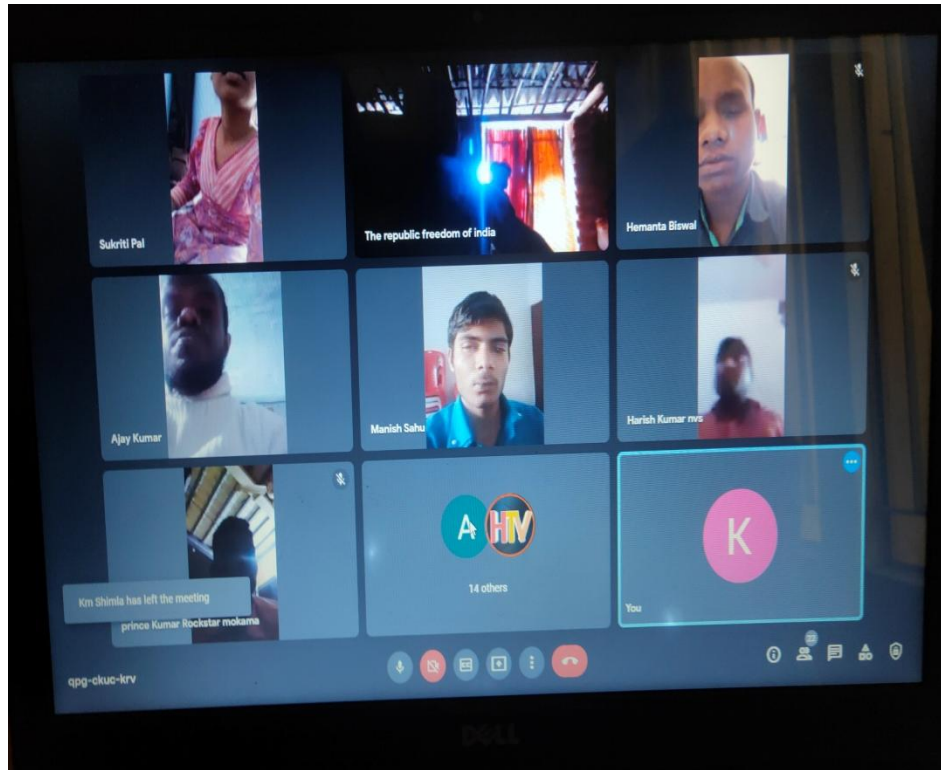
❖ Staff review meeting was held on 18th and 19th October 2021. The review was conducted by Mr. Vivek Kumar Singh, consultant for N.B.C.D.



❖ In India, November 17 is observed every year as National Epilepsy Day to create awareness about epilepsy. Epilepsy is a chronic disorder of brain characterized by recurrent ‘seizures’ or ‘fits’. A free epilepsy camp for children with disabilities was organised at Prerana Educational Centre, Demdima Basti, Salugara. The medical camp was conducted by Dr. Jeevan Silwal, Pediatric Neurologist and team from Athena Clinic, Siliguri. During the camp 11 Children were examined who were accompanied by their parents.



❖ Ms. Kavita Golyan, Computer Instructor of Prerana Educational Centre has conducted Hindi typing online class through Google Meet for visually impaired person. She successfully completed training 02 batches in the month of October and November 2021 respectively. 45 participants from various parts of the country took part in the training program.



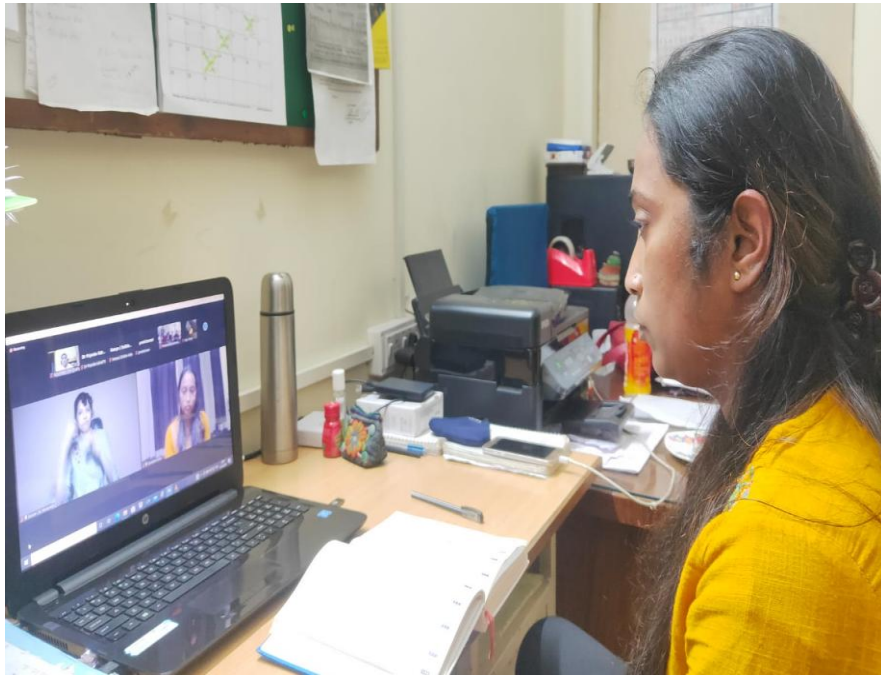
❖ International day for the persons with disabilities was observed by Prerana on 3rd December 2021. A cultural event was organised to celebrate the day. Students from G.D. Goenka Public School, Siliguri and Members of Lions Club Shatabdi, Siliguri were also present to observe the day along with the children, parents and staff members.



❖ Prerana Educational Centre had participated in Project Discovery, a flagship program initiated by Enable India since July 2021. This is an endeavour by EI labs to collect video solutions used by the person with disabilities, index the solutions and disseminate those to people who may benefit using them. Prerana submitted 202 video solutions out of which 172 videos were selected by the judges to be catalogued for further use. Prerana was awarded the 1st prize of Rs. 1 lakh for submitting highest number of videos. The results were announced on 3rd December via virtual programme.



❖ Prerana was invited by Enable India, Bangalore to present one of their solution videos which was submitted in Project Discovery. The virtual program was conducted on 10th Dec 2021. Sonamoni Saha, Asst. Teacher gave the online presentation and the program was attended by the staff members of PEC.



- ❖ Education support is being provided to 60 children with disability through online mode and phone calls. Remedial classes is being provided to 07 students.
- ❖ Home based therapy interventions and support is being provided to 66 beneficiaries at the community level.
- ❖ Tara Das Saha, Project Community Coordinator attended the virtual meeting of District Level SVEEP Monitoring and District Level Accessibility Committee and District Level Committee for Supervision and Monitoring on 17th December 2021.
- ❖ During the reporting period we were able to observe events like Gandhi Jayanti ,Durga Puja, Diwali, Children's Day on virtual mode. The children with the assistance from their parents and siblings made short videos of the activity which were later compiled into a video presentation form and hosted in social media platforms such as YouTube and Facebook. The children, parents, well wishers and staff members were also very happy and excited to see the children perform in a virtual medium.
