

## <u>Project Ankur</u> <u>Report – October 2021 to December 2021</u>



Teachers continue with the Online Virtual Sessions and keep parents involved to ensure that the learning of Children With Hearing Impairment goes on!



### Activity details:

### <u>1. Individual Virtual Sessions</u> :

Individual Virtual Sessions continued with the use of the virtual medium such as WhatsApp, video calls, text messages, and audio calls for reaching out to the children and parents at Malancha. For those with good Internet Connectivity, Google Meet was used.

The teachers have been coming to the Sadhan Centre and conducting the Virtual Sessions from there during the period.

A total of 407 sessions were conducted virtually from 01 Oct '21 to 31 Dec '21. A brief on the number of sessions is given below.

<u>2. Parents Meeting cum Workshop on Child Sexual Abuse :</u> was conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2021 at the Centre in Malancha







The objective of the Meeting was to address issues faced by parents to keep the children within the household due to the pandemic situation. The parents were also made aware of the vulnerability of their children who could become victims of abuse during the lockdown situation and to know how to ensure safety for their deaf children.

### 3. Learning through Directed Activity

Our teachers communicate to the children about why Diwali is celebrated – Lord Ram's victory over Ravana – also signifying victory of Good over Evil . People celebrate by lighting diyas, making Rangoli designs , bursting crackers and sharing sweets.

On 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> December 2021, **Christmas Activity** was also conducted in a similar way

This Activity was done as part of IEP Sessions when children were communicated about Christmas – celebration of the birthday of Jesus Christ. The Christmas tree is decorated , people go to the church to pray , the christmas cake is cut and shared with all and Santa Claus brings gifts for all .
